The benefits payable from the AVC Arrangement on the death of a member are:-

- I. the return of Member contributions paid to the Arrangement with interest and bonuses; and
- II. the balance of a pension guaranteed for five years where the member has died within 5 years of the start of payment of pension

You may inform the Trustee of how you would like the AVC Death Benefits to be distributed and the Trustee will take your wishes into account when deciding how to distribute the Benefits. The beneficiaries may normally be only the member's qualifying spouse, children, parents, grandparents, brothers, sisters and/or dependants.

Because the Trustee cannot be legally compelled to follow the your wishes, the AVC Death Benefits does not form part of a Member's Estate for Inheritance Tax (IHT) purposes and are therefore not liable to IHT.
