What do I do next?

As a Trustee Director of the Shell Contributory Pension Fund (the Fund), you will have an important role to play in the governance of the Fund. Before applying we recommend you do the following:

- Read the 'Introduction to Trusteeship' and the 'Selection Rules' available on the pensions website at pensions.shell.co.uk
- Visit The Pension Regulator's website at www.thepensionsregulator.gov.uk for an external view on what being a Trustee involves.
- Obtain a basic familiarity with the Fund (pensions.shell.co.uk) although full training will be provided if you are appointed. You can also get a better understanding of what is involved before you apply by joining one of the group calls with the Trustee Services Unit (TSU) senior management. Please email SCPFtrustee@shell.com if you are interested in joining one of the group calls (dates available on request) or if you would like to request a nomination form.

If you decide you want to apply:

- Complete the nomination form available from the TSU and submit it with your CV to SCPFtrustee@shell.com before 5pm on 30 September 2021.
- If you are an active member, talk to your line manager. Shell in the UK supports employees acting as Trustee Directors, but you should get approval from your line manager before submitting your nomination form.
- Ensure you are available for a telephone interview on either 18 or 19 October 2021.



The timetable

If your application is shortlisted, you will be invited to attend an interview with the Trustee Selection Panel. The key dates for the 2021 Member-Nominated Director selection are as follows:

Candidate nomination period closes	30 September 2021 (promptly at 5pm)
Telephone interviews	18 or 19 October 2021
Successful candidates appointed	1 January 2022
